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WITNESS STATEMENT

Procedure

1. I was introduced to [01/18] PRV and [01/18] PRV and told that they are investigators with the OTP of the ICC. I was also introduced to [01/18] PRV and told he is an interpreter for the OTP.
2. The investigators explained to me what the ICC is and described its mandate. They explained the role and mandate of the OTP within the ICC.
3. The investigators explained to me that they are investigating events that took place in the Central African Republic (CAR) since August 2012. I was informed that the OTP is contacting me because they believe I may have information relevant for establishing the truth.
4. I agreed that the interview would be conducted in French and English with the aid of a French-English interpreter. I fully understand and speak French.
5. The investigators explained to me that I do not have to answer their questions. I agree to tell the truth and that my answers are as complete as possible and reflect the best of my knowledge and recollection.
6. I was informed that any information I give to the OTP, including my identity, may be shared with the parties of the proceedings at the ICC; in particular the Judges, Accused persons, the Counsel of the Accused and the legal representatives of the victims.
7. The investigators have explained to me the reasons and importance of keeping my contacts with the OTP confidential, which I fully understand.
8. Having understood all the above issues, I confirmed my willingness to answer the investigators' questions.
9. The investigators explained to me how the interview was going to be conducted. I was told that I needed to be as accurate as possible in my account and that I should

state when I do not know the answer to or do not understand the question. I understand that I need to distinguish between what I have experienced or seen myself and what I have heard or learned about from someone else.

10. The investigators explained to me that the OTP is currently using [01/18] PRV Meetings software (with the required security features) to conduct some of its interviews because of the travel and other limitations imposed by the COVID-19 situation. I agreed that the interview is conducted this way and, that at the end of the interview, the investigators will produce a written statement which I will be asked to sign in the presence of [01/18] PRV Associate Investigator. I understand that the other OTP staff and the interpreter will then sign my statement electronically.
11. The OTP staff asked me to show them my identity card which is a Central African passport bearing the number [01/18] PRV

We heard information regarding the Seleka committing atrocities in BANGUI, about the killing of a magistrate in BRIA, about a certain OBAMA who was killed by the Seleka, and we heard about what happened at the Celestial Church. [01/18] PRV [01/18] PRV who were both part of the church, were detained by the Seleka, and [01/18] PRV negotiated for their release.

39. I followed what was happening in CAR. [01/18] PRV

40. When events take place in your country, you see publications on Facebook – that is how you find things out. At that time, I kept in touch with friends in BANGUI and friends abroad. The investigators asked me who I kept in touch with through Facebook. I did not remember, but they asked me if I knew [01/18] PRV

41. Previously, when we were in [01/18] PRV I did not really know [01/18] PRV but I had heard his name. He was [01/18] PRV [01/18] PRV

Meetings

44. I heard about meetings which were led by NGAISSONA, MOKOM père and David GBANGA, who was the former director of Radio Centrafrique. GBANGA was always with MOKOM père, but I do not know what his role was in all of this. I heard about these meetings from [01/18] PRV

[01/18] PRV during the meetings, they would say, 'We are going to back to BANGUI, we are going to organise ourselves with the Anti-Balaka to form an armed group to fight DJOTODIA'. I do not know what their strategy was, I just know they wanted to go back to BANGUI and regain power. The orders came from BOZIZE, NGAISSONA and MOKOM père. [01/18] PRV

46. In the meetings, they were all Gbaya. ACHILLE – I do not know his other name - was in BERTOUA, but if they called he would also attend the meetings. ACHILLE is a Gbaya. He is originally from BOSSANGO, but he fled to BERTOUA and had meetings with NGAISSONA and MOKOM père. He would contact them and they would send money for his transport, and he would then meet with them there. ACHILLE and KPEFIO were very close.

47. NGAISSONA and MOKOM père led the meetings, and they were always together at these meetings. [01/18] PRV told me this.

48. [01/18] PRV would share information regarding the meetings with me. [01/18] PRV

49. During their meetings, they spoke [01/18] PRV

50. I was asked what I can tell the investigators about FROCCA. I replied that I do not know anything about it. I was asked if I knew that YAKETE was a part of FROCCA. I replied that I heard about FROCCA on the radio, but I do not know what they did. I do not know anyone in the FROCCA. I do not know if ROD LARRY MARTIAL or KPEFIO were in FROCCA. You must know – everybody knows – that YAKETE was the founder and creator of FROCCA. Later on, I discuss FROCCA a bit more with the investigators.

51. When the investigators first mentioned FROCCA, I explained that I do not know a lot about FROCCA. However, at a certain point, [01/18] PRV
[01/18] PRV I wanted to find out about the return to the constitutional order.

52. [01/18] PRV However, I did hear about meetings that were happening for the Anti-Balaka, with NGAISSONA. I know that military people attended, and MOKOM père was there and that soldiers were given money to go to the border. NGAISSONA, MOKOM père and BOZIZE's aide de camp Colonel WAPOUNABA were there at the Golf, which was BOZIZE's residence in CAMEROON. [01/18] PRV

53. The Golf was a residence that President Paul BIYA had given to BOZIZE, before the latter went to UGANDA. If you went to the residence, you could get money from MOKOM père. NGAISSONA gave MOKOM père the money and MOKOM père was then in charge of giving it out. [01/18] PRV
[01/18] PRV that is how I know this. [01/18] PRV and I was told that NGAISSONA was giving out money to MOKOM to give to the soldiers. I do not know how they knew this. NGAISSONA and MOKOM gave 50,000 FCFA to each military man to go to GARAM BOULAL.

54. When they gave the money to the military men, they said 'Go to GARAM BOULAI and then cross the border and continue on to BOUAR, there are Anti-Balaka at BOUAR, join them there to fight the Seleka'.

61. Many FACA had gone to GARAM BOULAI in advance of crossing over the border to CAR. When you go there, you were supposed to contact a gendarme named SABE. His rank is *maréchal des logis chef*. He died during the fight with the Seleka in BELEKO.

[01/18] PRV He had been to YAOUNDE and had meetings with NGAISSONA. [01/18] PRV

[01/18] PRV he was going to a meeting with NGAISSONA. [01/18] PRV Following this meeting, NGAISSONA gave an instruction that everyone should find and meet SABE in GARAM BOULAI. [01/18] PRV

[01/18] PRV told me that NGAISSONA had given this instruction. I suppose it was to wait for orders or something. [01/18] PRV

62. [01/18] PRV ROCCA MOKOM (the son of MOKOM *père*, who died with the French journalist) and AARON OUILIBONA went to find where SABE's house was. Many soldiers went there, but I do not know their names.

63. If the Cameroonians found you, they would put you in prison, like they did with Steve YAMBETE. [01/18] PRV

[01/18] PRV

[01/18] PRV the Cameroonians caught GBANGOUA and LAMKAGUE and detained them in prison. If I am not mistaken, they were taken from BERTOUA to YAOUNDE. They also arrested PABANJDI, but released him.

64. [01/18] PRV he had been in some of the meetings with NGAISSONA and MOKOM *père* in YAOUNDE. [01/18] PRV

[01/18] PRV YAMBETE said to the MISCA. [01/18] PRV that he was the coordinator of the Anti-Balaka group that were at the border and who went to BELOKO. Before moving to CAMEROON, YAMBETE had been in ZAIRE.

65. [01/18] PRV

[01/18] PRV SABE already had elements from before this time – he was the Brigade Chief in KOUNDE near GARAM BOULAI, if I am not mistaken. When the Seleka arrived, he and his family moved to GARAM BOULAI.

66. Around this time, I received information from [01/18] PRV He told me that they were preparing themselves, and that soldiers had left GARAM BOULAI to fight in BABOUA, led by ARMEL EMTENOU, BOZIZE's nephew. Some civilians and some Anti-Balaka were involved, as well as AZOU MANDJI, who was a soldier and someone whose nickname was FALLI-FALLI, who was also a soldier. When DJOTODIA resigned, a gendarme named FILAI became a commander and the

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Chief of Staff for the Anti-Balaka in BELOKO. SABE and AARON OUILIBONA and ROCCA MOKOM were also involved in all of this.

68. I did nothing much during [01/18] PRV

69. When DJOTODIA resigned – I think it was on the 10th December or January - that same day at about 4PM the Anti-Balaka attacked the Seleka in BELOKO. FALLI-FALLI, ROCCA, OUILIBONA and AZOU MANDJI were already in BELOKO when the attack started. The following day, SABE joined them there.

70. They wanted revenge, because there were Muslims who had destroyed and looted their houses. They were against the Muslims. As you know, [01/18] PRV

their objective was revenge against the Muslims who had harmed them. When I say 'their' objective, I am referring to persons such as ROCCA and OUILIBONA.

71. In general, all around me, I heard them saying 'When we take the town, we must destroy and loot all the Muslim houses. If they have money, we must take the money'. They said that the Muslims who were in our country were not Central African, that they were originally from CHAD. These Muslims had fled the war in CHAD to come to our country and had children here who have Central African nationality. They said that it is those Muslims and their children who are harming us now, so we must finish them off. They said we must do away with them, so that there are no more Muslims in CAR.

72. Later, when they Anti-Balaka launched their attacks, they killed Muslim civilians. For instance, one Anti-Balaka [01/18] PRV had shot two Muslims as they tried to flee BABOUA, in order to take their motorbike, [01/18] PRV he had their motorbike and their many telephones (about eight) with him. This happened before DJOTODIA resigned. I cannot remember this Anti-Balaka's name, but he was arrested in GARAM BOUALI and sent to BERTOUA.

73. You could see that those at the border had been simple soldiers or civilians, and then all of a sudden they became Colonels and Commanders. For instance, ROCCA had been a civilian and he became a Colonel. FILAI had been a *maréchal des logis chef* and

76. When I got back to BANGUI, things were not easy. My wife and I stayed in *quartier* [01/18] PRV Chadian contingents were killing people, and in MISKINE Muslims were fighting the Anti-Balaka [01/18] PRV

83. The investigators showed me a document on the screen which shows Facebook messages exchanged between [01/18] PRV bearing the ERN CAR-OTP-[01/18] PRV and directed me to various pages on the document.

84. At [01/18] PRV The investigators asked me about the message [01/18] PRV 10/2013 [01/18] PRV [01/18] PRV KOKATE will soon arrive. I replied that this is 'just information' - the [01/18] PRV told me about this, so I informed [01/18] PRV [01/18] PRV Having thought about it, I now remember it is [01/18] PRV who told me. I did not ask him where he got that information from.

85. The investigators asked me about KOKATE [01/18] PRV He previously belonged to the Seleka. He was one of the signatories to the LIBREVILLE agreement, and was appointed the Minister for Small Business. The investigators asked me why [01/18] PRV wait for KOKATE in order to attack... I replied that this is the message [01/18] PRV [01/18] PRV everybody has their ambitions - the message says that in two days [01/18] PRV will be in BANGUI - but there were a lot of lies, and this did not happen in the end. [01/18] PRV [01/18] PRV waiting to go back to BANGUI, but it did not happen! [01/18] PRV the planning - the Gbaya did this. I just heard information and I passed it on. [01/18] PRV [01/18] PRV [01/18] PRV I passed it on of my own accord.

86. I heard that KOKATE went to the Golf residence to meet NGAISSONA and MOKOM père. I heard this from [01/18] PRV I do not know what they talked about there. I did not meet KOKATE [01/18] PRV

87. In BANGUI, KOKATE was Deputy Coordinator of the Anti-Balaka, but he did not get on with NGAISSONA and he eventually he resigned.

88. [01/18] PRV In these Facebook messages [01/18] PRV about MOKOM père. I cannot think of his first name right now. He is the one who gave out money on NGAISSONA's behalf, so that people would go to the border.

89. The investigators asked me what I meant when I said that MOKOM père was 'saving nothing'. I meant that it was not easy to live, to find food. [01/18] PRV

[01/18] PRV

[01/18] PRV We were hoping that KOKATE would give money to NGAISSONA, who would then give it to MOKOM père to distribute! [01/18] PRV

90. [01/18] PRV MOKOM père was giving out NGAISSONA's money, but I never received any money from him! [01/18] PRV

[01/18] PRV The investigators asked me why MOKOM père was giving NGAISSONA's money out. I do not know – NGAISSONA is like the boss, and he had trust in someone else to distribute the money. MOKOM père is one of BOZIZE's relatives, they are from the same village and they are Gbaya.

91. When BOZIZE left YAOUNDE, his former *aide de camp* Vincent WAPOUNABA looked after his residence, the Golf. WAPOUNABA had fled BANGUI together with BOZIZE, and they had stayed at the Hilton before moving to the residence. After BOZIZE left YAOUNDE, NGAISSONA went to live at the residence. MOKOM père then left the neighbourhood where he lived in YAOUNDE and went to live with NGAISSONA and WAPOUNABA. When NGAISSONA left for DOUALA or elsewhere for a few days on business, MOKOM would return to where he lived in his YAOUNDE neighbourhood. However, towards the end of 2013 NGAISSONA and MOKOM père lived together at the residence and neither one of them left without the other. I do not know the name of the neighbourhood. WAPOUNABA would stay on at the residence, together with the cook SOSTHÈNE. I heard all this from [01/18] PRV

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92. I do not know if NGAISSONA visited the residence while BOZIZE was still living there. I never visited any of them there, not even once. I knew they were living there together because [01/18] PRV [01/18] PRV

93. When DJOTODIA resigned, NGAISSONA and MOKOM père also lived together in BANGUI, and financed what the Anti-Balaka were doing. This was before MOKOM père separated from NGAISSONA to join his son Maxime MOKOM.

94. MOKOM père and NGAISSONA gave money to the soldiers to go to the border to join the Anti-Balaka. It was only later, when NGAISSONA returned to BANGUI, that we heard that he said he was the General Coordinator of the Anti-Balaka, so hence, in that role, he was financing the Anti-Balaka. For me, if he was their General Coordinator, he must have been financing them.

95. We all know that the Seleka came and killed people – the aim of NGAISSONA and MOKOM père was to fight off the Seleka. They gave money to soldiers in CAMEROON, so that they would go and join the Anti-Balaka and help them fight the Seleka. The ‘Seleka’ meant the soldiers who came from CHAD and SUDAN and the Muslims who supported them. The local Muslims were on the side of the Seleka.

96. The investigators asked me if NGAISSONA and MOKOM père told them to be careful not to harm Muslim civilians. I replied that I never heard this.

97. I can see that General NGAFEI is mentioned in a Facebook message at ERN CAR-OTP [01/18] PRV. He is the former Chief of Staff, and is also a relative of BOZIZE. I did not hear that NGAFEI played a role in sending FACA soldiers to join the Anti-Balaka.

98. At [01/18] PRV The investigators referred me to the message [01/18] PRV October 2013 [01/18] PRV

[01/18] PRV

President

BOZIZE was behind FROCCA, and I have mentioned Lévi YAKETE’s role in it. BOZIZE spoke about this on the radio – their goal was the return to the constitutional order. I had heard that those in FROCCA were having meetings, and I wanted to know more.

99. In the message, I asked if MOKOM and NGAISSONA were sending the FROCCA people to the field. I was seeking information – I was not amongst them, but I knew everything that was going on, so I asked questions to try to get information.

100. NGAISSONA was sending money and hunting ammunition ('00') to BOUAR. This was used for the attack on BOUAR. I do not remember when this attack on BOUAR was. The hunting ammunition was sent in Cube Maggi stock cube boxes. It was sent in convoys – at the time of the Seleka, they were not checked properly, and anyone who had a look would just think it was stock cubes. I did not see these Cube Maggi boxes myself. I do not know how the money was sent to the field. NDALE was the civilian chief of the archers in BOUAR, he would receive the ammunition and the money. After this attack, NDALE contacted ACHILLE and told him that they were out of ammunition in BOUAR and needed more. ACHILLE told NDALE to contact NGAISSONA and MOKOM père directly and tell them the problem. [01/18] PRV [01/18] PRV

101. I do not know where NGAISSONA obtained this ammunition from. I just heard that it was provided by people in CAMEROON.

102. Money and hunting ammunition was also sent to BANGUI. It reached BANGUI before the big attack of 5th December. Again, the ammunition was sent in Cube Maggi boxes and I do not know how the money was sent. Many people that I know – [01/18] PRV [01/18] PRV told me about this.

105. The investigators pointed me to where [01/18] PRV said he does not accept how this was put together, saying that it was bad coordination and it was too fast. I remember that there was an Anti-Balaka attack when DJOTODIA was in power, and YAKETE spoke on RFI saying that he was in the field. However, he was not, he was in TOGO.

107. The investigators asked me whose idea it was that the FACA join the Anti-Balaka. I do not know. NGAISSONA and BOZIZE are from the same village – we say they are relatives. NGAISSONA and MOKOM père had to inform BOZIZE before they made any decisions. Everybody knew this, it was not just me.
108. MOKOM père [01/18] PRV was in touch with BOZIZE [01/18] PRV they would call each other on the phone. That is why NGAISSONA wanted MOKOM père near him – because of this relationship with BOZIZE.
109. Later, when NGAISSONA returned to BANGUI, he fell out with MOKOM père, because the former wanted to be a candidate in the 2015 presidential elections. NGAISSONA said he would not support BOZIZE. NGAISSONA also fell out with Maxime MOKOM and a division appeared in the Anti-Balaka.

MOKOM Père

110. NGAISSONA and MOKOM père worked together. [01/18] PRV [01/18] PRV they were always together apart from when NGAISSONA left on business, as I explained earlier. They remained together until they returned to BANGUI in 2014.

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I knew of two people who had already crossed over to BOUAR - a *sous-lieutenant* named KAMBASSEO and a son of BOZIZE's elder brother named Hector EMTENOU [01/18] PRV

[01/18] PRV I later learned that Didier DANBOY and Jules PESSERE also crossed over to BOUAR.

BOUAR and Supplies

117. The investigators asked me if the fighting for BOUAR was finished at [01/18] PRV [01/18] PRV (10/2013). I replied that it was ongoing. In BOUAR, there were mainly Christian civilians doing the fighting and they needed the military to reinforce them.

118. The investigators asked me if there were soldiers and ammunition sent to other locations. I mainly know about BOUAR. A Thuraya was also sent to BOUAR to a Captain whose name I forget - he was the second *aide de camp* to BOZIZE. I told the investigators that I did not know where NGAISSONA and MOKOM *père* obtained the Thurayas. [01/18] PRV

119. I also heard that NGAISSONA sent ammunition and a Thuraya to ANDJILO in BOUCA. I do not remember who I heard that from, but I know that it is true. I also speak about this again later. In addition, [01/18] PRV

[01/18] PRV said that MOKOM and NGAISSONA promised to send [01/18] PRV some Thurayas.

120. I did not hear about weapons being provided to the Anti-Balaka. I know that the military had hidden or buried their weapons in CAR, so they could use them on their return. I think they were hidden in BOSSANGO and other places along the way to GARAM BOULAI, but I am not sure exactly where. I heard this in

[01/18] PRV from many Gbaya soldiers close to BOZIZE - I do not know their names.

121. You will have heard that NGAISSONA was the General Coordinator of the Anti-Balaka, so he was obviously in control of the whole movement. Around September 2014, YEKATOM RAMBO's group was no longer under NGAISSONA's control. NGAISSONA and RAMBO used to have meetings, but they no longer collaborated from around that time onwards. RAMBO had killed soldiers of the same ethnic group as NGAISSONA so RAMBO and his elements could no longer go to BOY-RABE.

122. The investigators told me that they also have Facebook messages [01/18] PRV

I can remember this. I mentioned ACHILLE earlier - he is in exile in BERTOUA. ALESCO and ACHILLE are related. ALESCO is a Colonel and a *commissaire* in the police [01/18] PRV

GBANGOUMA and LAMKAGUE were arrested, so they did not finish their mission.

150. GBANGOUMA and NGAISSONA did not get on, because GBANGOUMA was on the side of DAZOUMI, SANI YALO and MECKASSOUA, and NGAISSONA was on the side of BOZIZE. I do not know why, in 2013, MECKASSOUA was no longer on BOZIZE's side. DAZOUMI and SANI YALO also did not get on with NGAISSONA. This is what I heard [01/18] PRV

151. The goal of DAZOUMI and SANI YALO, MECKASSOUA and their group was to get power and install MECKASSOUA as the President of CAR. They promised GBANGOUMA that he would become a General, if they took power.
