I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby informs Trial Chamber V (“Chamber”) of the appointment of Mr Mamadou Diarrassouba (“Mr Diarrassouba”) as Legal Adviser to Witness P-1839 (“Notification of Appointment”), pursuant to rule 74 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”).

II. Classification

2. Pursuant to regulation 23 *bis*(1) of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), the annexes to the present submission are classified as confidential, as they contain personal information and contact details of Mr Diarrassouba.

III. Applicable Law

3. The Registry has considered the following provisions: article 68 of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 74 of the Rules, regulations 67 and 69 of the RoC, regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (“Code”).

IV. Submissions

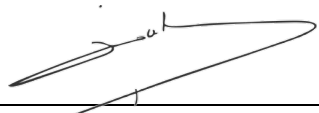
4. On 29 September 2022, the Registrar appointed Mr Diarrassouba as the Legal Adviser to Witness P-1839.¹ Mr Diarrassouba will be duly provided with access to the relevant material in connection with the case, including the statements and transcripts of interviews of Witness P-1839, *via* a secure channel in order to maintain confidentiality at all times.²
