I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby informs Trial Chamber V (“Chamber”) of the appointment of Mr John Philpot (“Mr Philpot”) as Counsel to Witness P-2625 (“Notification of Appointment”), pursuant to rule 171(5) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”), in the context of his testimony before the Chamber.

II. Classification

2. Pursuant to regulation 23 *bis*(1) of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), the annexes to the present submission are classified as confidential, as they contain personal information and contact details of Mr Philpot.

III. Applicable Law

3. The Registry has considered the following provisions: articles 64 and 68 of the Rome Statute, rules 21, 65 and 171(5) of the Rules, regulations 67 and 69 of the RoC, regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for Counsel (“Code”).

IV. Submissions

4. On 13 October 2022, the Registrar appointed Mr Philpot as Counsel to Witness P-2625.¹

5. On 13 October 2022, Mr Philpot executed the solemn undertakings required by articles 5 and 22(3) of the Code.²
