I. NOTIFICATION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") submits this communication regarding the disclosure of evidence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The filing and its annex are classified as "Confidential" as they relate to evidence disclosed relating to *inter partes* communications and a decision of the same designation.¹

III. DISCLOSURE OF EVIDENCE

3. On 14 June 2023, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Maxime Mokom "Pre-confirmation Metadata Update Package 009" containing 84 items.
4. The disclosure of "Pre-confirmation Metadata Update Package 009" consists of items classified as INCRIM or Rule 77 for which a metadata update to the field "Disclosure Notes (external)" has been undertaken. Following the Chamber's order,² the Prosecution has identified portions in this field within the disclosed items, which are potentially exonerating under article 67(2) of the Statute.
