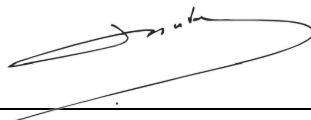

I. Transmission

1. On 14 August 2023, the Trial Chamber VI ("Chamber") ordered the Registry to file on the case record the report of the appointed Panel of Experts ("Panel of Experts' Report") within 15 days after having finalised their examination of Mr Said,¹ the Registry therefore hereby transmits, as annexes I and II, the Panel of Experts' Report.

II. Classification

2. Considering regulation 24bis of the Regulations of the Court and regulation 14(d) of the Regulations of the Registry, the present submission and its Annex are classified as Secret *ex parte* only available to the Registrar, the Detention Section and the Defence for Mr Said, since (1) they follow the level of classification ordered in the Chamber's Decision,² and (2) they refer to sensitive information from the Panel of Experts labelled medical confidential.
3. The Registry has applied redactions to the names of one ICC staff member and two doctors in order to protect their privacy.
