I. INTRODUCTION

1. On 20 March 2024, the Appeals Chamber ordered the Defence for Mr Patrice-Édouard Ngaïssona ('Defence') to file public redacted versions of its filings, ICC-01/14-01/18-2171-Conf, ICC-01/14-01/18-2206-Conf and ICC-01/14-01/18-2207-Conf, or request their reclassification as 'public', by 16h00 on 3 April 2024.
2. Accordingly, the Defence seeks the reclassification, as public, of filing ICC-01/14-01/18-2171-Conf titled "Consolidated Defence Request for an Extension of Page and Time Limits". After a careful review, the Defence is of the view that none of the information mentioned in the aforementioned document warrants redaction and that the entirety of the document can be reclassified as public.
3. For the reasons set out above, the Defence respectfully requests the Appeals Chamber to direct the Registry to reclassify ICC-01/14-01/18-2171-Conf as public.
