I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby transmits to Pre-Trial Chamber I ("Chamber"), a request received on 25 June 2024, from an individual named Eli M. Rosenbaum, to submit observations in the present Situation as Amicus Curiae, in accordance with rule 13(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

1. On 25 June 2025, the Registry received by post mail a *"Request Under Rule 103 for Leave of Court to File the Attached Observations Regarding the Prosecutor's Application for Issuance of Arrest Warrants in Connection with the Gaza/Israel War"* ("Request") together with a nine-page submission entitled *"Observations Submitted by Eli M. Rosenbaum (in his personal capacity), in accordance with Rule of Procedure 103, to Pre-Trial Chamber I of the International Criminal Court Concerning the Need for the Court to Explore Evidence of Bias, Including Employment of Unfair Double Standards, in Connection with the ICC Prosecutor's Application for Issuance of Arrest Warrants in Connection with the Ongoing Gaza/Israel War"* ("Submission").
2. On the same day, the Registry sought guidance from the Chamber on how to proceed with the Request and the Submission.
3. The Chamber instructed the Registry to ("Instructions") :
 - submit the Request only in the record of the Situation *via* a Registry's transmission filing,;

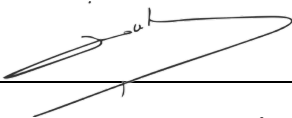
- file the transmission filing and the Request on a Secret basis¹ and,
- annex the Request to the transmission filing.²
