I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby transmits to Pre-Trial Chamber I ("Chamber"), a request received on 28 June 2024, from Professor David Chilstein, to submit observations in the present Situation as Amicus Curiae, in accordance with rule 103(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

2. On 27 June 2024, the Chamber issued its *"Public redacted version of 'Order deciding on the United Kingdom's request to provide observations pursuant to Rule 103(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, and setting deadlines for any other requests for leave to file amicus curiae observations' ('Order')"*.¹
3. On 28 June 2024, the Registry received an e-mail from Professor David Chilstein attaching an "Application for Leave to Submit Observations as Amicus Curiae pursuant to Rule 103 (1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence" ("Application").²
4. On 1 July 2024, the CMS contacted the Chamber to seek guidance on how to process this Application.³
5. The Chamber instructed the Registry to ("Instructions"):

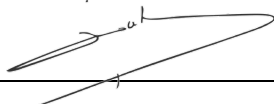
- submit the Application only in the record of the Situation *via* a Registry's transmission filing;

- annex the Application to the transmission filing.
