I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby transmits to Pre-Trial Chamber I ("Chamber"), a request received on 30 June 2024, from Professor John Quigley, to submit observations in the present Situation as Amicus Curiae, in accordance with rule 103(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

2. On 27 June 2024, the Chamber issued its *"Public redacted version of 'Order deciding on the United Kingdom's request to provide observations pursuant to Rule 103(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, and setting deadlines for any other requests for leave to file amicus curiae observations' ('Order')"*.¹
3. On 30 June 2025, the Court Management Section ("CMS") received an e-mail from Professor John Quigley attaching a "Request for Leave to File Submissions Pursuant to Rule 103" ("Request").²
4. On 1 July 2024, the CMS contacted the Chamber to seek guidance on how to process this Request.³
5. The Chamber instructed the Registry to ("Instructions"):
 - submit the Request only in the record of the Situation *via* a Registry's transmission filing;

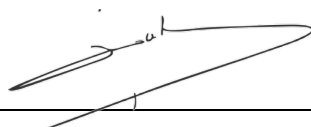
- submit the transmission filing and the Request on a Secret basis⁴ and;
