I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby submits the present report (“Report”) and its two annexes consisting of a confidential version of items recognised as evidence formally submitted and its public redacted version, pursuant to the “Directions on the Conduct of Proceedings” (“Directions”),¹ issued on 9 March 2022 by Trial Chamber VI (“Chamber”).

II. Procedural History

2. On 9 March 2022, the Chamber issued its Directions on the Conduct of Proceedings in which it instructed the Registry to: “[...] reflect all formally submitted items in the eCourt metadata [...]”, and to “[...] submit reports for each witness who testifies, indicating which items have been formally submitted by the parties and participants in relation to that witness. The email exchanges [...] are to be annexed to this filing, applying redactions as appropriate.”²
3. On 24 October 2022, the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) called its fourth witness, witness CAR-OTP-P-2105 (“P-2105”). After the conclusion of the examination of witness P-2105, the parties formally submitted items used during the hearings of the aforementioned witness, as instructed by the Chamber in the Directions.
4. On 24 November 2022, the Chamber, via email, issued its decision on items of evidence recognised as being formally submitted for P-2105.³
5. Pursuant to the Directions, the Registry applied redactions as appropriate to the emails enclosed in Annex 1 to the present filing⁴.

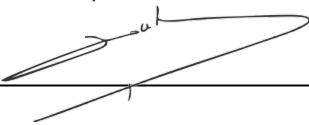
IV. Submission
