I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby submits the present report (“Report”) and its two annexes consisting of a confidential version of items recognised as evidence formally submitted and its public redacted version, pursuant to the “Directions on the Conduct of Proceedings” (“Directions”),¹ issued on 9 March 2022 by Trial Chamber VI (“Chamber”).

II. Procedural History

2. On 9 March 2022, the Chamber issued its Directions on the Conduct of Proceedings in which it instructed the Registry to: “[...] reflect all formally submitted items in the eCourt metadata [...]”, and to “[...] submit reports for each witness who testifies, indicating which items have been formally submitted by the parties and participants in relation to that witness. The email exchanges [...] are to be annexed to this filing, applying redactions as appropriate.”²
3. On 16 January 2023, the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) called its fifteenth witness, witness CAR-OTP-P-1737 (“P-1737”). After the conclusion of the examination of witness P-1737, the parties formally submitted items used during the hearings of the aforementioned witness, as instructed by the Chamber in the Directions.
4. On 8 February 2023, the Chamber, via email, issued its decision on items of evidence recognised as being formally submitted for P-1737.³
5. Pursuant to the Directions, the Registry applied redactions as appropriate to the emails enclosed in Annex 1 to the present filing⁴.

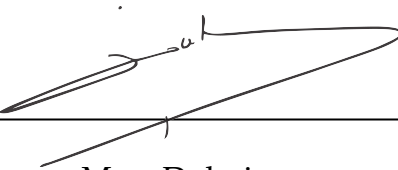
IV. Submission
