I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby transmits to Pre-Trial Chamber I ("Chamber"), a request received on 6 August 2024, on behalf of the Simon Wiesenthal Centre entitled "Renewed Request to Reconsider Decision ICC-0118-249 of 22 July 2024 under Rule 103" ("Request").¹

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

2. On 22 July 2024, the Chamber issued its "*Public Decision on Requests for leave to file observations pursuant to rule 103 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence*".²
3. On 06 August 2024, the Registry received an e-mail from Mr Robert Gillmore, with the Request attached thereto.³
4. On the same day, the Registry sought the Chamber's guidance as to how to process the Request.⁴
5. The Chamber instructed the Registry to file the Request in the record of the Situation *via* a Registry transmission filing with the Request appended thereto ("Chamber's Instruction").⁵

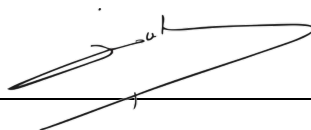
