I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby transmits to Pre-Trial Chamber I (“Chamber”) through attached Annex I and II, “Observations under article 68(3) on behalf of victims of Palestinian terror”, as received on 15 August 2024 (“Observations”) from the Shurad HaDin- Israel Law Center (“Submitter”).¹

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

2. On 15 August 2024, the Registry received an e-mail from the Submitter, with the Observations attached thereto.²
3. Since the deadline of 12 August 2024, set by the “Decision regarding the views, concerns, and general interests of victims”³ has passed, the Observations were not filed in the Situation record.
4. Upon inquire and follow up by the Submitter, the Registry received a forwarded e-mail from the Submitter with the Observations, indicating that these were sent to the Registry Court Management-Court Records email address (“CRA Inbox”) on 12 August 2024 at 08:57.

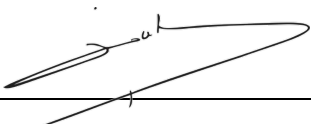
