I. INTRODUCTION

1. Following the Trial Chamber V's ('Chamber') "Decision on the Fourth Ngaïssona Defence Request for Submission from the Bar Table and Requests for Leave to Add (Miscellaneous Documents) and Decision on the Prosecution Further Rebuttal Request",¹ the Defence for Mr Patrice-Édouard Ngaïssona ('Defence') hereby provides in Annex A to this filing its updated List of Evidence ('updated List').
