## **I. Introduction**

1. The Registry hereby informs Pre-Trial Chamber III (“Chamber”) that Ms Kate Gibson (“Ms Gibson”) has been appointed as associate counsel for Mr Joseph Kony (“Mr Kony”) to represent him during the confirmation process and the confirmation hearing before the Court. The appointment has been formalized by letter dated 27 August 2024.

## **II. Classification**

2. In accordance with regulation 23 *bis*(2) of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), Annex I to the present submissions is classified as confidential, as it contains confidential information related to the appointment of Ms Gibson and her private contact details.

## **III. Applicable Law**

3. The following provisions are of particular relevance to the present submissions: articles 43 and 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulations 23*bis*, 67 of the RoC, regulations 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry and articles 5, 11, 12, 16 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (“Code”).

## **IV. Submissions**

4. On 27 August 2024 the Registry formalised the appointment of Associate Counsel<sup>1</sup>.

5. Ms Gibson has previously executed the solemn undertaking as required by the Code, which remains valid throughout the proceedings before the Court.<sup>2</sup>

5. Ms Gibson confirmed to the Registry that she does not have impediments to the representation of Mr Kony in the proceedings before the Court or a conflict of interest in accordance with articles 12 and 16 of the Code.<sup>3</sup>
