I. Introduction

1. In furtherance of Pre-Trial Chamber II's ("Chamber") "Decision inviting Mongolia to provide any further submissions on its failure to arrest and surrender Vladimir Vladimirovich Putin" ("Decision")¹ dated 10 September 2024, the Registry hereby submits to the Chamber a note verbale received from the Embassy of Mongolia to the Kingdom of Belgium dated 3 October 2024 transmitting both a note from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the submissions of Mongolia.
2. The Chamber decided to grant Mongolia a limited extension of the time limit until Thursday, 3 October 2024² on the basis of the request made by Mongolia and transmitted in the "Registry transmission of communication received from Mongolia in relation to Pre-Trial Chamber II's Decision inviting Mongolia to provide any further submissions on its failure to arrest and surrender Vladimir Vladimirovich Putin dated 10 September 2024 (ICC-01/22-86-Conf)."³

II. Classification

3. In accordance with regulation 23 *bis*(2) of the Regulations of the Court, the present request is classified as confidential *ex parte* only available to the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution"), in line with the classification of the Decision. Annex I is likewise classified as confidential *ex parte* only available to the Prosecution. The Registry notes that the authorities of Mongolia have no objection for their submissions to be classified as "public".

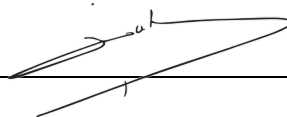

4. The following provisions are of particular relevance to the present transmission: articles 86, 87, 92 and 97 thereof, rules 13(1) and 176(2) of the Rules, and Regulation 35 (2) of the Regulations of the Court ("Regulations").

IV. Submissions

5. On 3 October 2024, at 2.13 (The Hague time), the Registry received a note verbale (Reference number N°A/24-1441)⁴ sent by the Embassy of Mongolia to the Kingdom of Belgium transmitting the submissions of Mongolia in reply to the Chamber's Decision dated 10 September 2024.
6. The Registry remains at the disposal of the Chamber for any further information and will keep the Chamber apprised of any further developments.
