I. Introduction

1. In relation to Pre-Trial Chamber II's ("Chamber") "Finding under article 87(7) of the Rome Statute on the non-compliance by Mongolia with the request by the Court to cooperate in the arrest and surrender of Vladimir Vladimirovich Putin and referral to the Assembly of States Parties" issued on 24 October 2024¹ and rule 13(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, ("Rules"), the Registry hereby submits to the Presidency a note verbale received from the Embassy of Mongolia to the Kingdom of Belgium dated 29 October 2024.

II. Classification

2. The present transmission and Annex are submitted as public as the Embassy of Mongolia indicated that its submission does not contain classified information.

III. Applicable law

3. The following provisions are of particular relevance to the present transmission: Part 9 of the Rome Statute ("Statute"), and in particular articles 41, 82, 86, 87, 92 and 97 thereof, rules 13(1), 34, 155, and 176(2) of the Rules, and Regulation 35 (2) of the Regulations of the Court.

IV. Submissions

4. On 29 October 2024, at 3:12 PM hrs (The Hague time), the Registry received a note verbale (Reference number No A/24-095) by the Embassy of Mongolia to the Kingdom of Belgium. In the Note Verbale, the Mongolian authorities submitted its "Application for the Disqualification of Judges" to the Presidency. Along with the same note verbale, the Embassy of Mongolia submitted its requests to Pre-Trial Chamber II ("Chamber") for a temporary stay of

proceedings, as well as for leave to appeal based on Article 82(1)(d) of the Statute.

5. On 30 October 2024, at 12:04 PM hrs (The Hague time), the Embassy of Mongolia re-submitted its requests, addressing the note verbale separately to the Chamber and the Presidency. The present filing therefore includes the request addressed to the Presidency.
6. The Registry remains at the disposal of the Presidency for any further information and will keep the Presidency apprised of any further developments.
