I. Introduction

1. In relation to Pre-Trial Chamber II's "Finding under article 87(7) of the Rome Statute on the non-compliance by Mongolia with the request by the Court to cooperate in the arrest and surrender of Vladimir Vladimirovich Putin and referral to the Assembly of States Parties" issued on 24 October 2024¹ and considering rule 13(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules"), the Registry hereby submits to the Appeals Chamber ("Chamber") a note verbale received from the Embassy of Mongolia to the Kingdom of Belgium dated 1 November 2024.

II. Classification

2. The present transmission and Annex are classified as public as the Embassy of Mongolia indicated that its submission was not classified.

III. Submissions

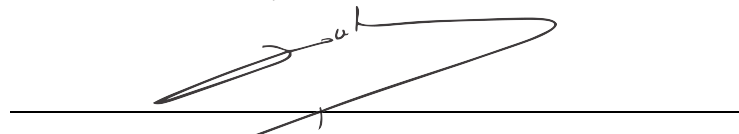
3. On 1 November 2024, at 12:21 PM hrs (The Hague time), the Registry received a Note Verbale (Reference number No A/24-098) by the Embassy of Mongolia to the Kingdom of Belgium. In the Note Verbale, the Mongolian authorities submit their "Urgent Request for Suspensive Effect" to the Appeals Chamber.
4. This request follows Mongolia's "Request to Leave to Appeal" and "Request for a temporary stay of proceedings" submitted to Pre-Trial Chamber II on 29 October 2024², as well as the "Application for the Disqualification of Judges" submitted to the Presidency on 29 October 2024³.
