I. Introduction

1. In relation to Mongolia's "Application for the Disqualification of Judges" of 31 October 2024,¹ and in accordance with rule 13(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Registry hereby submits to the Plenary of Judges of the International Criminal Court ("Plenary of Judges") a Note Verbale received from the Embassy of Mongolia to the Kingdom of Belgium on 12 November 2024, along with Mongolia's "Additional Submission in Support of the Application for Disqualification of Judges".²

2. The present transmission and Annex are classified as public as the Embassy of Mongolia to the Kingdom of Belgium indicated that its submission was not classified.

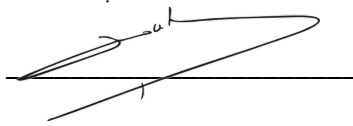
III. Submissions
