I - Transmission

1. Pursuant to Pre-Trial Chamber's II ("Chamber") instruction issued by way of email,¹ the authorities by the Central African Republic ("CAR"), on 14 November 2024, transmitted to the Registry a public redacted version of their challenge to the admissibility of the case of Mr Edmond Beina before the Court ("Admissibility Challenge").² The CAR authorities confirmed that the content of the annexes to their Admissibility Challenge should maintain their original level of classification in application of the secrecy principle in accordance with article 71) B of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Special Criminal Court.³
2. The Registry hereby transmits the public redacted version of the Admissibility Challenge⁴ as well as the letters received from the CAR authorities and the Special Criminal Court transmitting the said document.⁵

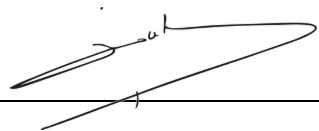

II- Classification

3.
