I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby transmits to Pre-Trial Chamber I (“Chamber”), a document, received on 10 September 2024, from the State of Israel, entitled *“Request for leave to reply to the “Prosecution Response to Israel’s “Request to extend the page limit for submission concerning article 18(1)” (ICC-01/18-345-SECRET-Exp)”* (the “Request”).

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

2. On 21 August 2024, the Registry transmitted to the Chamber a *“Request to extend the page limit for submission concerning article 18(1)”*.¹
3. On 5 September 2024, the Prosecution submitted its *“Response to Israel’s “Request to extend the page limit for submissions concerning article 18(1)” (ICC-01/18-345-SECRET-Exp-Anx)”*.²
4. On 10 September 2024, the Registry received an e-mail from [REDACTED], on behalf of the State of Israel, with a document attached thereto entitled *“Request for leave to reply to Prosecution Response to Israel’s “Request to extend the page limit for submission concerning article 18(1)” (ICC-01/18-345-SECRET-Exp-Anx)”*.³
5. The same day, the Registry contacted the Chamber to request some guidance on how to submit the Request.⁴

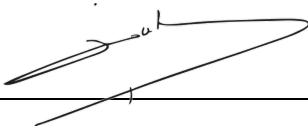
6. On 12 September the Chamber instructed the Registry to submit the request *via* a Secret transmission filing (the “Instruction”).⁵
