I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby transmits to Judge María del Socorro Flores Liera, President of the Pre-Trial Division (“President of the Pre-Trial Division”), a submission received on 2 December 2024, from Amnesty International, titled *“Victims’ Request for Clarification and an Order to Compel the Prosecutor to Act on their Legal Obligations under Article 15(3)”* (the “Request”).

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

2. On 2 December 2024, the Registry received an e-mail from Amnesty International, with five documents attached consisting in the Request and four annexes¹.
3. On the same day, the Registry liaised with the Chamber to seek guidance on how to submit the Request and its annexes onto the case record.²
4. In its response, the Chamber instructed the Registry to submit the Request *via* a Registry’s transmission filing (“Instruction”).³
