I. Introduction

1. The Registry submits the present document and its annex consisting of the revised E-court protocol pursuant to the “*Decision Setting the Disclosure Regime*”, issued on 12 December 2024, by Pre-Trial Chamber III (“Chamber”).¹

II. Procedural History

2. On 29 October 2024, the Chamber issued its “*Decision on the criteria for holding confirmation of charges proceedings in absentia*”.²
3. On 12 December 2024, the Chamber issued its “*Decision Setting the Disclosure Regime*”,³ in which it ordered the Registry to file the E-court Protocol into the case record.⁴
4. On 19 December 2024, the Registry submitted “Registry Submission of a proposed E-court protocol”.⁵
5. On 3 January 2025, the Prosecution submitted its “Request to Deviate from the E-Court Protocol”.⁶
6. On 16 January 2025, the Prosecution informed the Chamber of the constructive discussions held with the Registry regarding the requested changes to the E-court

Protocol via email. In addition, the Prosecution communicated to the Chamber that a revised version of the Protocol would be filed by the Registry in the case record.⁷
