The Appeals Chamber of the International Criminal Court,

In the review by the Court concerning reduction of sentence of Mr Al Hassan Ag Abdoul Aziz Ag Mohamed Ag Mahmoud pursuant to article 110 of the Statute,

Noting that, on 26 June 2024, Trial Chamber X rendered its decision entitled “Trial Judgment” in which Mr Al Hassan Ag Abdoul Aziz Ag Mohamed Ag Mahmoud was convicted on eight counts of crimes against humanity and war crimes (ICC-01/12-01/18-2594-Red),

Recalling that, on 20 November 2024, Trial Chamber X issued the “Sentencing Judgment”, sentencing Mr Al Hassan Ag Abdoul Aziz Ag Mohamed Ag Mahmoud to 10 years of imprisonment and ordering that the time that he spent in detention be deducted from the total period of imprisonment (ICC-01/12-01/18-2662),

Noting that, on 28 November 2024, Mr Al Hassan Ag Abdoul Aziz Ag Mohamed Ag Mahmoud had served two thirds of his sentence,

Noting that, on 18 September 2024, the Defence and the Prosecutor filed their respective notices of appeal against the “Trial Judgment” (ICC-01/12-01/18-2648 and ICC-01/12-01/18-2649, respectively),

Recalling that, on 17 December 2024, the Defence and the Prosecutor filed notices of discontinuance of their respective appeals against the “Trial Judgment” (ICC-01/12-01/18-2667 and ICC-01/12-01/18-2668, respectively),

Considering that article 110(3) of the Statute, read with rule 224(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, provides in relevant part that “[w]hen the person has served two thirds of the sentence, [...] the Court shall review the sentence to determine whether it should be reduced”,

Noting that Mr Al Hassan Ag Abdoul Aziz Ag Mohamed Ag Mahmoud chose not to appeal his conviction or sentence,

Recalling further the Defence’s “Request to compose an article 110(3) panel” of 16 January 2025 (ICC-01/12-01/18-2675),

Renders, by majority, Judge Luz del Carmen Ibáñez Carranza and Judge Solomy Bossa dissenting, the following

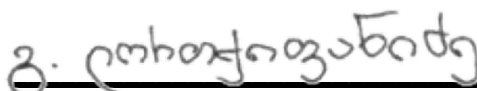
