I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby transmits to Trial Chamber X (“Chamber”), a “*Request for leave to file submission on reparations issues pursuant to Article 75 of the Statute*” (“Request”) received on 12 February 2025 from the Queen's University Belfast Human Rights Centre (the “Submitter”).

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

2. On 12 February 2025, the Registry received an e-mail from the Queen's University Belfast Human Rights Centre, with one document attached consisting in the Request¹.
3. On 13 February 2025, the Registry consulted with the Chamber to obtain guidance on the submission of the Request onto the case record.²
4. On 13 February 2025, in its response, the Chamber instructed the Registry to submit the Request *via* a Registry’s transmission filing (“Instruction”).³
