## I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby transmits to Trial Chamber X (“Chamber”), a *“Request for Leave to File Amici Curiae Observations pursuant to Article 75 of the Statute and Rule 103 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence”* ( “Request”) received on 14 February 2025 from Mama Koité Doumbia, l’Association des Femmes pour les Initiatives de Paix (AFIP), le Groupe de Recherche, d’Etude, de Formation Femme-Action (GREFFA), Women’s Initiatives for Gender Justice (WIGJ), the International Federation for Human Rights (FIDH), REDRESS, Lawyers Without Borders Canada (LWB Canada), Akila Radhakrishnan, Alexandra Lily Kather and Sareta Ashraph (the “Submitters”).

## II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

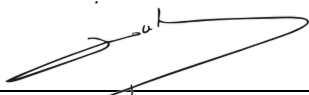
