I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby transmits to the Appeals Chamber (“Chamber”), the *“Judicial Integrity in Peril – Request for the Appeals Chamber to Conduct an Ex Officio Review of the Prosecutor’s Conflict of Interest in the Venezuela I Situation”* (the “Request”) received on 24 March 2025 transmitted by Robert Carmona-Borjas on behalf of the Arcadia Foundation, (the “Submitter”).

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

2. On 24 March 2025, the Registry received an e-mail from Robert Carmona-Borjas and the Arcadia Foundation, with one document attached consisting of the Request¹.
3. On the same day, the Registry consulted with the Chamber to obtain guidance on the submission of the Request and its annex onto the case record.²
4. On 8 April 2025, the Chamber instructed the Registry to submit the Request as public *via* a Registry’s transmission filing (“Instruction”).³

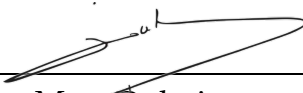
