Trial Chamber X (the ‘Chamber’) of the International Criminal Court, in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Al Hassan Ag Abdoul Aziz Ag Mohamed Ag Mahmoud*, having regard to article 75 of the Rome Statute and rule 143 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, issues the following ‘Order scheduling a reparations hearing’.

1. On 26 June 2024, the Chamber, by majority, convicted Mr Al Hassan Ag Abdoul Aziz Ag Mohamed Ag Mahmoud for the commission of three counts of crimes against humanity and five counts of war crimes.¹
2. On 13 December 2024, the Chamber issued its ‘Order for Submissions on Reparations’ in which it, *inter alia*, instructed the parties and participants to make submissions on reparations.²
3. On 11 March 2025, the Chamber issued its ‘Decision on the requests for leave to submit amicus curiae observations’³, in which it, granted leave for amicus curiae to submit observations and notified the parties, participants and amicus curiae that it intends to schedule a reparations hearing.
4. The Chamber hereby notifies the parties and participants that the hearing will be held the week of 15 September 2025. The Chamber will provide further details as to the exact date and time of the hearing in due course.
5. The Chamber invites the Legal Representative of Victims (the ‘LRV’) and the Defence to address the Chamber on their submissions on reparations and make any final observations. The Chamber invites the Prosecution, the Trust Fund for Victims (the ‘TFV’) and the Victims Participation and Reparations Section (the ‘VPRS’) to attend the hearing. At a later date, the Chamber may invite amici curiae to attend the hearing. The Chamber will also notify the parties of the time allotted to make their final submissions on reparations at a later date.
6. The Chamber informs the parties, participants and amici curiae that it may ask questions during the hearing. To the extent possible, the Chamber will provide these questions in writing prior to the hearing.

7. The Chamber decides that the order of the hearing will be as follows:

- The LRV's final submissions on reparations;
- The Defence's final submissions on reparations;
- Questions from the Chamber.

8. The Chamber notes the importance of the public, and more specifically the victims, being able to view the hearing on reparations. Therefore, the submissions will, in principle, be presented in public session. The Chamber will only authorise private sessions for very discrete instances where the parties and participants must refer to confidential information.

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS, THE CHAMBER HEREBY

ORDERS that the reparations hearing will be held during the week of 15 September 2025;

INVITES the LRV and the Defence to make submissions during the hearing;

INVITES the Prosecution, the TFV and the VPRS to attend the hearing.
