I. SUBMISSIONS

1. Pursuant to Pre-Trial Chamber III's "Decision Setting the Disclosure Regime,"¹ and the order of the Single Judge,² the Prosecution respectfully submits Annex A, containing a revised table of its witnesses concerning material disclosed to the Chamber, Defence, and Parties.³
2. The Prosecution notes that, in line with the Single Judge's order, the table was amended to indicate the number of witnesses,⁴ page numbers, and individual single rows per witness containing the documents starting with the witness statement, transcripts of the interview, annexes, and other documents related to the witness, where relevant. The table includes all witnesses relied on in the Prosecution's Pre-Confirmation Brief and List of Evidence.
