I. NOTIFICATION

1. The Prosecution submits this communication regarding the disclosure of evidence to the Defence, in compliance with rules 76(3) and 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence. The disclosure of these items was effected in response to a series of *inter partes* requests made by the Defence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annexes, appended to this filing, are classified as “Confidential” as they refer to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. DISCLOSURE OF EVIDENCE

3. On 12 May 2025, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence five new items.

4. The items are organised under the following disclosures:

- a. Pre-Confirmation INCRIM package 022 12 May 2025, containing two items, listed in Confidential Annex A; and
- b. Pre-Confirmation Rule 77 package 016 12 May 2025, containing three items, listed in Confidential Annex B.

5. The Prosecution also updated and re-disclosed the metadata of six items already disclosed, as contained in:

- a. Pre-Confirmation Metadata Update package 001 12 May 2025 (two items), listed in Confidential Annex C; and
- b. Pre-Confirmation Metadata Update package 002 12 May 2025 (four items), listed in Confidential Annex D.

6. The Prosecution further takes the opportunity to advise the Chamber, Parties and Participants that, also following *inter partes* discussions, it will shortly be disclosing additional translations/transcripts of audio-video items from its List of

Evidence. These translations/transcripts are currently being worked on and should be available for disclosure in early June 2025.

7. At this point, there are no outstanding items for pre-confirmation disclosure known to the Prosecution. The Prosecution will, as required, continue to review its collection in light of new inquiries or developments in the case.
