I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby transmits to Pre-Trial Chamber I (“Chamber”), Hungary’s submission in response to the “Invitation to Hungary to provide submissions for the purposes of proceedings under article 87(7) of the Rome Statute” (“Submission”), received on 22 May 2025 from the Embassy of Hungary to the Kingdom of the Netherlands (“Submitter” or “Hungary”).

II. Procedural History

2. On 16 April 2025, the Chamber invited Hungary to submit, by 23 May 2025, observations regarding its failure to provisionally arrest Mr Benjamin Netanyahu pursuant to the Warrant of Arrest issued on 21 November 2024 (“Invitation”).¹ On the same day, the Registry transmitted the Invitation pursuant to the Chamber’s instructions.²
3. On 24 April 2025, the Embassy of Hungary transmitted a Note Verbale confirming receipt of the Invitation and its onward transmission to the competent Hungarian authorities.
4. On 22 May 2025, Hungary provided the Registry with its submissions by way of Note Verbale.³

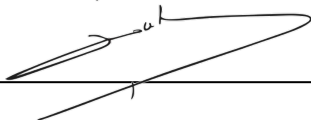
