I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby transmits to Pre-Trial Chamber I (“Chamber”), a document entitled “*Communication by the State of Palestine requesting notification pursuant to Rule 59*”, (“Communication”), which was received from the State of Palestine (“Submitter”) on 20 May 2025.

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

2. On 24 April 2025, the Appeals Chamber issued its “*Judgment on the appeal of the State of Israel against Pre-Trial Chamber I’s “Decision on Israel’s challenge to the jurisdiction of the Court pursuant to article 19(2) of the Rome Statute”*”.¹
3. On 5 May 2025, the Prosecution submitted its “*observations regarding the procedure to be followed following the issuance of the warrants of arrest against Benjamin NETANYAHU and Yoav GALLANT and the Appeal Judgment ICC-01/18-422 OA2*”.²
4. On 9 May 2025, the State of Israel submitted its “*Request to Have Arrest Warrants Withdrawn or Vacated and Response to Prosecution Observations dated 5 May 2025*”.³

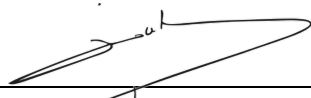

5. On 20 May 2025, the Registry received an e-mail from the Submitter with a document attached consisting of the Communication.⁴
6. On 21 May 2025, the Registry consulted with the Chamber to seek guidance on the inclusion of the Communication in the case record.⁵
7. On 22 May 2025, the Chamber instructed the Registry to file the Communication in the case record *via* a public transmission filing ("Instruction").⁶

8. The Registry hereby transmits the Communication as an annex, in accordance with the Chamber's Instruction.
