PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER I (the ‘Chamber’) of the International Criminal Court (the ‘Court’) issues this decision.

1. On 23 September 2024, the State of Israel (‘Israel’) challenged the jurisdiction of the Court pursuant to article 19(2) of the Rome Statute (the ‘Statute’ and ‘Israel’s Challenge’).¹
2. On 21 November 2024, the Chamber issued the ‘Decision on Israel’s challenge to the jurisdiction of the Court pursuant to article 19(2) of the Rome Statute’ (the ‘Article 19(2) Decision’), rejecting Israel’s Challenge as premature.²
3. On the same day, the Chamber issued three warrants of arrest, including against Benjamin Netanyahu (Mr Netanyahu) and Yoav Gallant (Mr Gallant).³
4. On 27 November 2024, Israel filed a notice of appeal against the Article 19(2) Decision before the Appeals Chamber pursuant to article 82(1)(a) of the Statute.⁴
5. On 13 December 2024, Israel filed its appeal brief against the Article 19(2) Decision (the ‘Appeal’).⁵
6. On 24 April 2025, the Appeals Chamber issued its judgement on Israel’s Appeal (the ‘Judgement’).⁶
7. On 28 May 2025, the Chamber issued a decision on the conduct of proceedings and other procedural matters (the ‘Decision on the conduct of proceedings’).⁷
8. On 2 June 2025, the Office of Public Counsel for Victims (the ‘OPCV’) requested the Chamber to appear before it pursuant to regulation 81(4) of the Regulations of the Court (the ‘Regulations’).⁸

9. The Chamber recalls that, in its previous composition, it authorised the OPCV to present observations on two separate occasions in relation to the *Situation in the State of Palestine* on matters related to jurisdiction.⁹

10. The Chamber notes regulation 81(4)(c) of the Regulations, and the OPCV's submissions that it 'has been approached by Victims and Victims' organisations [who have not] formally appointed counsel of their own choosing'.¹⁰ In the interest of giving all victims who have communicated with the Court an opportunity to be heard, the Chamber authorises the OPCV to submit the views of victims who (i) fall within the scope of the cases against Mr Netanyahu and Mr Gallant respectively, (ii) have communicated with the OPCV prior to the issuance of the Decision on the conduct of proceedings, and (iii) have not identified their own legal representatives in the process.

11. In accordance with regulation 38(2)(c) of the Regulations, the OPCV's observations shall not exceed 60 pages. The Chamber further instructs the OPCV to submit such observations by no later than Friday, 27 June 2025.

12. Israel may also respond to the OPCV's observations in the consolidated reply it is invited to submit on 11 July 2025.

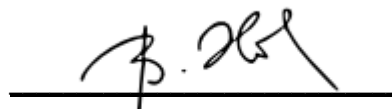
