I. NOTIFICATION

1. The Prosecution submits this communication regarding the disclosure of evidence to the Defence, in compliance with Pre-Trial Chamber I's (the "Chamber") order¹ and pursuant to articles 61(3)(b) and 67(1)(a) and (b) of the Statute, and rules 76(3) and 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annexes to this filing are classified as "Confidential" as they refer to confidential evidence disclosed *inter partes*.

III. DISCLOSURE OF EVIDENCE

3. On 27 June 2025, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence 1062 items, organised under the following thematic categories:

- a) Pre-Confirmation INCRIM package 025 27 June 2025: Crimes Against Humanity – Murder – Davao Death Squad, Mayoral Period (7 item listed in Confidential Annex A);
- b) Pre-Confirmation INCRIM package 026 27 June 2025: Crimes Against Humanity – Murder – Barangay Clearance Operations, Presidential Period (435 items listed in Confidential Annex B);
- c) Pre-Confirmation INCRIM package 027 27 June 2025: Crimes Against Humanity – Murder – High Value Targets, Presidential Period (64 items listed in Confidential Annex C);
- d) Pre-Confirmation INCRIM package 028 27 June 2025: Crimes Against Humanity – Modes of Liability (86 items listed in Confidential Annex D);
- e) Pre-Confirmation INCRIM package 029 27 June 2025: Crimes Against Humanity – Contextual Elements (50 items listed in Confidential Annex E);
- f) Pre-Confirmation INCRIM package 031 27 June 2025: Crimes Against Humanity – Contextual Elements (101 items listed in Confidential Annex F);
