I. NOTIFICATION

1. The Prosecution submits this communication regarding the disclosure of evidence to the Defence, in compliance with rules 76(3) and 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.
2. The disclosure of these items was effected pursuant to the Chamber's order of 15 August 2025. Although the Prosecution had disclosed the items in full compliance with the eCourt Protocol in the case, and several technical solutions to avoid file format changes have also been provided to the Registry since January 2025, the Registry has not undertaken the required updating of the document viewer. In the interim, and in view of the Chamber's order dated 15 August 2025 and the imminent confirmation hearing, the disclosure re-provides the four affected files in an alternative format compatible with the current system viewer provided by the Registry's eCourt system "JEM" to ensure immediate accessibility.
