I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby transmits to the Presidency, the “Applicant’s Response to the Prosecutor’s Communication Seeking Excusal in the *Venezuela I Situation* and Renewed Request that the Appeals Chamber Exercise Its Supervisory Authority to Safeguard the Court’s Integrity” (“Request”) received on 20 August 2025, from Mr Robert Carmona-Borjas and the Arcadia Foundation.

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

2. On 20 August 2025, the Registry received an e-mail from Mr Robert Carmona-Borjas and the Arcadia Foundation, with one document attached consisting of the Request.¹
3. That same day, 20 August 2025, the Registry consulted with the Presidency to obtain guidance on the appropriate procedure for submitting the Request and its annex into the case record.²
