I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby transmits to Trial Chamber V ("Chamber") the "Request for leave to file submission on reparations issues pursuant to Article 75 of the Statute" ("Request"), received on 31 October 2025, from Queen's University Belfast Human Rights Centre ("QUBHRC").

II. Procedural History

2. On 8 October 2025, the Chamber issued its "Order for Submissions on Reparations", inviting interested persons or organisations, particularly with local expertise, to request leave to make submissions in accordance with paragraph 6(iv) thereof, by 14 November 2025.¹
3. On 31 October 2025, the Registry received an e-mail from QUBHRC, with one document attached consisting of the Request.²
4. On the same day, 31 October 2025, the Registry consulted with the Chamber to obtain guidance on the submission of the Request onto the case record.³
5. The Chamber further instructed the Registry to submit the Request as public *via* a Registry's transmission filing ("Instruction").⁴

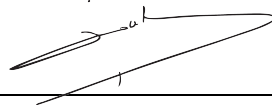
