The Appeals Chamber of the International Criminal Court,

In the appeal of Mr Edmond Beina against the decision of Pre-Trial Chamber II entitled “Decision on the Central African Republic’s challenge to the admissibility of the case against Edmond Beina” of 12 September 2025 (ICC-01/14-217-Red),

Having before it the “Victims’ Response to ‘Defence Appeal brief against the “Decision on the Central African Republic’s challenge to the admissibility of the case against Edmond Beina”” of 28 October 2025 (ICC-01/14-224-Conf),

Pursuant to regulation 23bis(3) of the Regulations of the Court,

Renders the following

ORDER

The Registrar is directed to reclassify as public filing ICC-01/14-224-Conf by 16h00 on 14 November 2025.

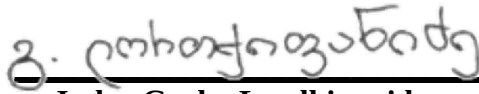
REASONS

1. Regulation 23bis(3) of the Regulations of the Court provides that a chamber may reclassify a document when the basis for the classification no longer exists.
2. Noting that the public redacted version of the “Defence Appeal Brief against the ‘Decision on the Central African Republic’s challenge to the admissibility of the case against Edmond Beina”” (ICC-01/14-220-Red) was filed on 6 October 2025,¹ and further noting the Office of the Public Counsel for Victims’ indication that the filing can be reclassified as “public”,² the Appeals Chamber finds that no reason exists for the “Victims’ Response to ‘Defence Appeal brief against the “Decision on the Central African Republic’s challenge to the admissibility of the case against Edmond Beina”” (ICC-01/14-224-Conf) to remain confidential. Therefore, the Registrar is directed to reclassify filing ICC-01/14-224-Conf as public.
