THE REGISTRY of the International Criminal Court (“the Court”);

I. Introduction

1. On 6 November 2025, Pre-Trial Chamber III (“Chamber”) issued its “Decision on the confirmation of charges *in absentia* against Joseph Kony pursuant to articles 61(2)(b) and 61(7) of the Rome Statute”¹ (“Decision”) in which it ordered *inter alia* the Registrar to transmit the Decision and the record of these proceedings to the Presidency.²
2. In addition, Pre-Trial Chamber III ordered the Registry to make appropriate arrangements so as to ensure that the Decision is translated into Acholi without delay.³

II. Level of confidentiality

3. Annexes 1 to 3 to the present transmission are classified as secret and confidential, *ex parte* only available to the Presidency as they refer to secret, under seal, confidential and confidential *ex parte* submissions that should only be accessible to the Presidency at this stage of the proceedings.

III. Applicable law

4. This filing is submitted pursuant to rule 129 of the Rules of Procedure and evidence, regulation 23bis (1) of the Regulations of the Court and in compliance with the Decision.

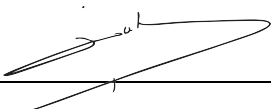
