TRIAL CHAMBER IV (the ‘Chamber’) of the International Criminal Court, in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Abdallah Banda Abakaer Nourain*, pursuant to Regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court (the ‘Regulations’), issues this ‘Order on the re-classification and redaction of prior submissions, decisions and transcripts’.

1. The Chamber recalls the procedural history as set out in its Order scheduling a status conference.¹
2. On 13 November 2025, pursuant to Regulation 23 *bis*(2) of the Regulations, the Prosecution requested (i) the reclassification as confidential—accessible to the Prosecution, Defence and the Registry—of several submissions, and (ii) authorization to file confidential redacted versions of other filings (‘Prosecution's Request’).²
3. At this stage of proceedings, the Chamber considers there is no justification to maintain the classification *ex parte*. Additionally, the Chamber considers that documents classified as confidential listed in paragraph 9 of the Prosecution's Request must also be notified to the Legal Representative of Victims.

FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER HEREBY

GRANTS the Prosecution’s request.

ORDERS the reclassification to confidential of the documents listed in paragraph 9 of the Prosecution's Request.

AUTHORISES the Prosecution to file confidential redacted versions of the documents listed in paragraph 10 of the Prosecution's Request.

ORDERS the Registry to notify the Legal Representative of Victims of the documents listed in paragraph 9 and 10 of the Prosecution's request.
