I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby informs Pre-Trial Chamber I (“Chamber”) that on 4 December 2025, Mr Khaled Mohamed Ali El Hishri (“Mr El Hishri”) requested to be represented by Mr Yasser Mohamed Ahmed Hassan (“Mr Hassan”) in the proceedings before the International Criminal Court (“Court”).

II. Procedural history

2. On 10 July 2025, the Chamber issued a warrant of arrest for Mr El Hishri for alleged crimes against humanity and war crimes in the Situation in Libya.¹
3. On 1 December 2025, Mr El Hishri was surrendered to the Court and arrived at the Court’s Detention Centre that same day.
4. On 2 December 2025, the Registry appointed Mr Hassan as counsel for Mr El Hishri for the initial appearance hearing, pursuant to the latter’s expressed wish that Mr Hassan be assigned to his representation.²

III. Classification

5. Pursuant to regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), Annex II to the present submission is classified as confidential as it contains the private contact details of Mr Hassan.

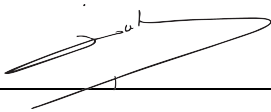

IV. Applicable Law

6. The following provisions are of particular relevance to the present submission: article 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulations 23*bis*, 67, 69 and 73 of the RoC, regulations 123 of the Regulations of the Registry and articles 5 and 8 of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (“Code of Conduct”).

V. Submissions

7. On 4 December 2025, Registry representatives visited Mr El Hishri at the Detention Centre in relation to his legal representation in the proceedings before the Court. During this meeting Mr El Hishri indicated that he wished to be assisted by Mr Hassan.³
8. On the same day, Mr Hassan accepted the mandate, as required by article 11 of the Code of Conduct.
9. On 5 December 2025, the Registry formalised the appointment of Mr Hassan as Counsel for Mr El Hishri.⁴
