I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby transmits to Pre-Trial Chamber I (“Chamber”), the *“Request for leave to reply to Prosecution Response to Israel’s “Request to Disqualify the Prosecutor and for Ancillary Remedies (ICC-01/18-471-Anx1)”*, (“Request”), received from the Embassy of Israel in The Hague (“Submitter”), on 05 December 2025.

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

2. On 05 December 2025, the Registry received an e-mail from the Embassy of Israel, with a document attached consisting of the Request.¹
3. On the same day, the Registry consulted the Chamber to seek guidance on whether and how to place the Request on the case record.²
4. The Chamber subsequently instructed the Registry to submit the Request *via* a Registry transmission filing (“Instruction”).³
