I. Introduction

1. Following the “Decision on request for variation of restrictions to Mr Ngaïssona’s contacts and communications in detention” (“Decision on Request for Variation of Restrictions”)¹ issued by the Appeals Chamber (“Chamber”) on 16 September 2025, whereby the Registry was ordered to continue submitting, every six months, reports on the implementation of restrictions on Mr Patrice-Edouard Ngaïssona (“Mr Ngaïssona”)’s contacts, the Registry hereby submits the present report. The Registry has no concerns to report.

II. Procedural history

2. Pursuant to a series of decisions,² the following restrictions on Mr Ngaïssona’s contacts are currently in place: (1) non-privileged phone calls and non-privileged visits limited to the individuals on his non-privileged contact list, whose identity and contact details have been duly verified beforehand by the Chief Custody Officer (“CCO”), who may request the support of the Victims and Witnesses Section; (2) written correspondence limited to the individuals on

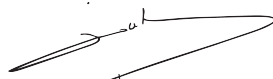
his non-privileged contact list; (3) non-privileged communications limited to the languages of French and Sango; (4) the prohibition of obscure or coded language; and 5) to refrain “from discussing or in clear or coded language: [...] any identifying information about victims and witnesses and their family members, such as names, pseudonyms, references to their work, or family links; and [...] whereabouts of victims and witnesses and their family members”.³

IV. Applicable law

3. For the purpose of the present submission, the Registry has considered regulations 99(1)(i) and 100 of the Regulations of the Court, and regulations 168, 169, 170, 173, 174, 175, and 183 of the Regulations of the Registry (“RoR”).

V. Submissions

4. Since its previous report on the implementation of the restrictions on contacts of Mr Ngaïssona,⁴ the Registry has no concerns to report.
5. Pursuant to regulation 175(1) of the RoR, the Acting CCO has conducted random monitoring of Mr Ngaïssona’s non-privileged telephone calls. As previously explained,⁵ random monitoring consists of listening to a selection of such calls. On the basis of this monitoring, the Registry has no concerns to report.
