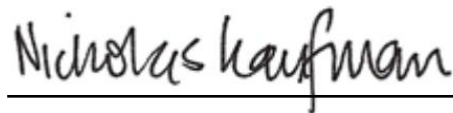

The Principal Counsel of the OPCV

1. Pursuant to Rule 121(6)¹ and the Pre-Trial Chamber's order,² the Defence hereby submits its Updated List of Evidence, as Confidential *ex parte* Annex A to this filing.
2. Pursuant to Regulation 23bis(1),³ the Annex is filed as confidential *ex parte* to the Prosecution and the Principal Counsel of the OPCV only, pending the adjudication of the Defence's request to disqualify the External Legal Representatives for Victims and to revoke their access to the case record.⁴ The Annex, however, is made available to the Principal Counsel of the OPCV, who has notified the parties and the Pre-Trial Chamber that she, and she alone, "is the designated OPCV counsel to act in the CLRV team".⁵
