I. Introduction

1. Following the “Sixth Decision on Mr Yekatom’s Restrictions on Contacts and Communications in Detention” (“20 May 2022 Decision”)¹ issued by Trial Chamber V (“Chamber”) on 20 May 2022, whereby the Registry is ordered to provide the Prosecution, the Defence for Mr Yekatom and the Chamber with the transcript of a conversation of Mr Alfred Yekatom (“Mr Yekatom”) during his non-privileged telephone call of 4 April 2022 and the identity of the interlocutor, the Registry hereby transmits the transcript of the non-privileged telephone conversation.²
2. On 14 June 2022, following an email request for clarification from the Registry,³ the Chamber considered “it sufficient, at this point, to provide the Prosecution only with the extracts of the call with the non-approved individual” and ordered the Registry to “provide the full version of the transcript to the Chamber, as well as the Yekatom Defence” (“Chamber’s Email”).⁴

II. Classification

3. In accordance with regulation 23 *bis*(2) of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), the present submission is classified as confidential *ex parte* only available to the Prosecution, Defence for Mr Yekatom and Registry as it refers to a decision with the same level of classification and contains third-party and personal information pertaining to Mr Yekatom’s private life. Annex I to the present submission is classified as confidential *ex parte*, available only to the Defence for Mr Yekatom and Registry, and the redacted version of Annex I is classified as confidential *ex parte* redacted, only available to the Prosecution,

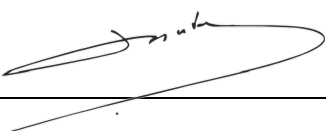
