I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") requests Pre-Trial Chamber II ("Chamber") to direct the Registry to provide the Prosecution with additional ICC Detention Centre telephone logs of NGAÏSSONA from 21-28 February 2021 pursuant to article 57(3). The Prosecution incorporates herein the entirety of the *Request for Order to Obtain Certain ICC Detention Unit Records of Patrice-Edouard Ngaïssona*¹ ("First Request").

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Request is filed as "Confidential, *EX PARTE*, available only to the Prosecution" because they contain sensitive information pertaining to witness security. The Request also contains confidential information about the Prosecution's on-going investigation.

III. SUBMISSIONS

3. From [REDACTED], the Prosecution interviewed Prosecution Witness [REDACTED] in person in The Hague after he completed his testimony before Trial Chamber V.² The Prosecution sought to clarify [REDACTED] account of the events he observed related to suspected offences against the administration of the justice. [REDACTED] as described in the First Request.³ However, he approximated that the conversation took place the week following [REDACTED].

4. As the time frame provided by [REDACTED] was not included in the First Request, the Prosecution seeks to i) apprise the Chamber of the variance in the account of the witness; and ii) amend its First Request to include the date range

provided by [REDACTED]. The Prosecution considers that the slight variance of a few days is not material, and may naturally occur when a witness truthfully approximates the time frame in which events occur.

IV. RELIEF SOUGHT

5. For the above reasons, the Prosecution respectfully requests that the Chamber issue an order directing the Registry promptly to provide the information sought from the ICC Detention Unit.
