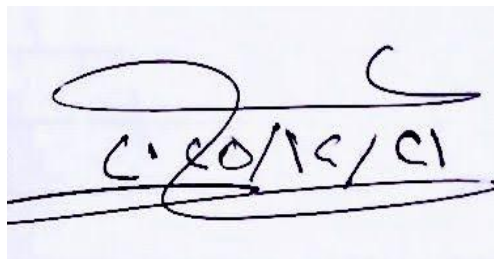

1. On 11 February 2026, the Chamber granted the General Coordination Committee of the IDPs and Refugee Camps in Sudan ("GCC") leave to participate in the reparations proceedings as an *amicus curiae*.
2. On 2 April 2026, the Chamber issued a decision in which *inter alia* a hearing concerning reparations was scheduled for 8 September 2026. All participating *amici* were invited to file a request to participate by 4 May 2026.
3. On behalf of the GCC, the Wayamo Foundation respectfully requests leave to attend the reparations hearing scheduled for 8 September 2026. The Wayamo Foundation recognizes that the leave application is late. Owing to conditions on the ground in Darfur, it has been exceedingly difficult to get a quorum within the GCC together to provide their consent for the present application. The members were brought together today (7 May) for a separate consultative process in Kalma camp and consent for the present application was provided.
4. The Wayamo Foundation apologizes for the delay and humbly requests the Chamber to nevertheless consider granting the request for leave to attend the reparations hearing in this case. If granted, a representative from the GCC as well as two lawyers from the Wayamo Foundation would be on hand during the hearing to address any questions posed by the Chamber, should they arise.
