TRIAL CHAMBER III (the ‘Chamber’) of the International Criminal Court, in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Rodrigo Roa Duterte*, pursuant to Article 64(3) of the Rome Statute (the ‘Statute’) and Rule 132(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the ‘Rules’), issues this ‘Order Setting the Agenda for the Second Status Conference’.

1. On 27 May 2026 the Chamber held its first status conference in this case,¹ in which it announced that a second status conference would take place on 23 June 2026.²

2. On 12 June 2026, the Chamber invited the parties, participants and the Registry to suggest any specific item to be discussed during the second status conference.³

3. On 17 June 2026, the Prosecution transmitted its suggested items for the status conference,⁴ whilst the Defence and Registry indicated they had no item to suggest.⁵

4. The Chamber takes note of the suggestions submitted by the Prosecution, as well as other matters that are either pending or have come to its attention.

5. The Chamber therefore issues the following agenda for the status conference:

- Deadlines for the filing of observations to the Expert Panel Report(s)
- Adoption of a Protocol on handling confidential information
- Page limit of the Prosecution’s Trial Brief
- Dates for next status conferences after the judicial recess
- Public statements made by counsel

6. Having regard to the limited number of issues to be discussed at the status conference, the Chamber will sit from 10:00 to 12:00.
