I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby submits its observations further to the Chamber having ordered it to provide observations, by 18 May 2026¹, on the the “Prosecution’s Request for materials in the custody of the Registry” (“Request”)² following the implementation of the Warrant of Arrest for Mr Rodrigo Roa Duterte, issued by Pre-Trial Chamber I on 7 March 2025.³

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

2. On 14 March 2025, the Registry submitted its “Report on the Arrest and Surrender of Mr Rodrigo Roa Duterte”.⁴
3. On 1 April 2025, the Registry submitted its “Addendum to the Report of the Registry on the Arrest and Surrender of Mr Rodrigo Roa Duterte”.⁵
4. On 1 May 2026, the Prosecution submitted its Request.⁶
5. On 7 May 2026, the Chamber ordered the Registry to submit observations on the Request.⁷

III. LEVEL OF CLASSIFICATION

6. Pursuant to regulation 23 *bis*(1) and (2) of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), the present submission and its annex are classified as confidential *ex parte* only available to the Defence and the Registry as it contains

information pertaining to the detention record of a detained person pursuant to regulation 92 of the RoC and regulation 192(2) of the Regulation of the Registry (“RoR”). A confidential redacted version is filed concomitantly.

IV. OBSERVATIONS

7. The Court Management Section (“CMS”) has in its custody [REDACTED].⁸
8. Pursuant to regulation 192 of the RoR, upon Mr Duterte’s admission to the ICC Detention Centre (“DC”), an inventory of his personal belongings was made (“Inventory on Admission”). These items from part of Mr Duterte’s detention record pursuant to regulation 92 of the RoC and 192(2) of the RoR. The Registry annexes to the present submission the Inventory on Admission pursuant to regulation 92(2) of the RoC.⁹
9. From the Inventory on Admission, the following items, which appear to fall within the Request,¹⁰ are currently kept at the ICC DC by the Chief Custody Officer pursuant to regulation 192(1) and (3) of the RoR:

10. The other items from the Inventory on Admission were retained by Mr Duterte in accordance with regulation 192(3) of the RoR, and are considered

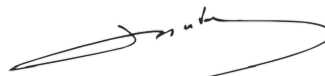

Mr Duterte's personal belongings pursuant to regulation 166(1) of the RoR unless the Chamber deems otherwise.
