TRIAL CHAMBER VII (the ‘Chamber’) of the International Criminal Court, in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Khaled Mohamed Ali El Hishri* (the ‘*El Hishri* case’), issues this ‘Decision notifying the election of the Presiding Judge and the Single Judge’.

1. On 20 July 2026, the Presidency constituted Trial Chamber VII, composed of Judges Miatta Maria Samba, Althea Violet Alexis-Windsor, and Beti Hohler, and referred to it the *El Hishri* case.

2. The Judges of the Chamber, pursuant to Rule 132*bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and Regulation 13(2) of the Regulations of the Court, have elected Judge Althea Violet Alexis-Windsor as the Presiding Judge and as the Single Judge for the preparation of the trial.

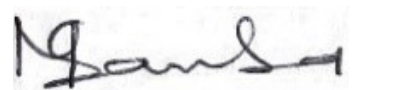
FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER HEREBY

DESIGNATES Judge Althea Violet Alexis-Windsor as the Presiding Judge and as the Single Judge.

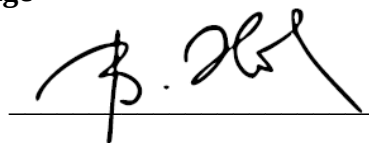
